History

- Located in the Pontiacq area, Menvielle Castle dates back to the 18th century. It was built
 on the remains of an ancient castle that testifies to the medieval past of the city and
 stands on a hill.
- From the first construction of the castle today graves are still preserved around the castle Menvielle. These were arranged before the construction of the castle on the orders of Ma Louise d'Artiguelouve in 1676.
- The present building is supplied with a slate roof.
- The inner courtyard opens towards the west, with a square tower at its end.
- In the 19th century a wide range of development work was done on the castel, to improve the comfort.
- The castel is listed for historical memorials and is in privat ownership.


Location

- The castel "Château de Menvielle" is located in the village community "Pontiacq-Viellepinte", region of Pyrénnées Atlantiques.
- Next nearby airports are in Pau or Tarbes, which are about 1 hour away.
- The pilgrim center Lourdes is 25 minutes away.
- The City Vic-en-Bigorre offers all needed infrastructures, which is 20 min. away.
- The nearby Pyrenees are in 11/2 hour reachable and offer many outdoor activities like skiing, snowshoe hiking, cycling, hiking, water rafting, paragliding, hiking and many more.
- The Cote d`Agent and the famous surfing beaches von Biarritz are in 1hr. 40 min reachable.
- The area offers a light tourism with its world know Juracon wine-growing region, its pilgrim center in Loudres and Basque ham.

Description

- Over the last 20 years the castel has been in private ownership.
- There is possible developing land on the grounds of about 2.940m².
- The property is ideal for leisure activities like Polo.
- The property is provided with 4 double horse boxes, tack room and a paddock with outdoor boxes.
- The region is also know as a Polo Mecca. There are various of Polo-clubs nearby like in Toulouse, Biarritz and Bordeaux.
- A large stone floored terrace for nice summer evenings.

- Ground floor: Reception, large living room, office, lounge, dining room, kitchen (possibility for a winter garden), guest toilet.
- 1st floor: master bedroom with a bathroom and dressing room, another master bedroom with separate bathroom, TV room, office.
- Top floor: tower room with gallery, 4 separate rooms, separate toilet with shower and bath.










